I'm Beige, have been in prison (a highly racialized world) for 14 years, and for the last 3 years have been gradually extricating myself from a pretty involved and decade-long racial trip that found me identifying, as most of us have in this country since Jim Crow, with one half of my ancestry to the exclusion of the other. I'm very interested to know of other Beige people who, for whatever their reasons may be, have eschewed this skewed notion of themselves in favor of a notion that more accurately reflects what they are.

So in any case, if you do run a magazine please let me know your subscription rate. And if you don't, I would be very interested to know of any such magazine or magazines, if you could send me their addresses (I'm enclosing a stamp, in case), and certainly of any means that might be available of communicating with other Beige people by mail.


